We have prayed for new churches in Taipei since before we moved to Taiwan in 1999. It isn't that the one we were working at isn't good. It is GREAT! And in fact that is why we were hopeful that the Taiwan Christian Church would make the decision to be a "church planting church". They have!

On December 31, 2006, we joined in a celebration and "sending-out" service for the Ankeng church. This service was highlighted by... everything that happened! It was beautiful.

2006 Financial Report

As you take a look at the numbers below... I can't guess how you'll feel. You might feel like the space would be better used in reporting more news about the ministry. I wouldn't necessarily disagree with you, but I do see how God has taken care of our ministry and family through you, our faithful supporters. Can I point out a few special cases? This year we spent about \$25,000 more than we usually do. Our move to Ankeng necessitated a vehicle purchase and we attended a month of training during our home service. Along with our airfare for home service, those items account for the increase over previous years. We were only able to pay for these additional expenses because of the corresponding increase in giving. As in previous years, you have given an amount that meets all of our needs no matter what they may be. I don't foresee any large expenses this year, but our God is extraordinary and so are our supporters.
