

48 Hour Prayer Room

The highlight of April for many associated with our church and mission team was the 48 Hour Prayer Room we ran from April 23 to 25. We encouraged people to sign up to enter the prayer room and pray for 1 hour before passing the baton to the next person on the list.

Although many people initially felt intimidated at the thought of praying for 1 hour, nearly everyone said that their time in the room passed too quickly. Our theme for this prayer room event was "The Body of Christ" and we believe that it helped people focus on how God has gifted them and how he wants them to serve in his church to bring grace and light to his creation.

Leading up to the prayer room, I (Scott) taught 3 lessons on prayer to each of the congregations involved and found this to be helpful toward encouraging people to sign up for a time slot and to prepare their hearts for what God might want to converse with them about. It was important to be sure that people understood that prayer does not only consist of talking but that we must also spend considerable time simply being still and quiet before God.
