

Joplin

Previously an important regional city which most people only knew from the song “(Get Your Kicks On) Route 66”, everyone knows the city of Joplin now.

Joplin was our home for several years, including the time just before we moved to Taiwan. It is also where we spend a considerable amount of time when on home service as it is conveniently located for our travels. We also have family there. We were relieved to make contact with family after the tornado and discover that all of them and their homes were safe. With limited electricity and internet in their area, we discovered that we actually had more information about the tornado while sitting here in Taiwan. Some fellow missionaries (Skiles) had grandchildren at the Stained Glass Theater when the tornado hit and did not know their safety for several hours. Their family was OK, but some at the theater lost their lives. Over the next few days, we continued to hear from friends who had lost everything but their lives.

We have one supporting church in the Joplin area, Christ’s Church of Oronogo, and were proud of their response along with other churches in the area and Ozark Christian College as well. Our sending church, Calvary Christian in Bellevue, NE sent 2 groups with supplies and helping hands. I know that this tragedy moved many to respond in some way and these examples are representative of this response. We are glad to be connected to such loving and generous supporters. In a way, your response to the Joplin tragedy helps us deal with the trauma where we are since we can’t be there to help as we would like.

An earlier tornado in St. Louis tore the roof off of another coworker’s home church (Edwards) and the Taiwan Christian Church sent financial gifts to St. Louis and to Joplin churches (Ferguson and Villa Heights) to show solidarity with those who are hurting and to help rebuild. The family of God is a beautiful thing. Bless you all.

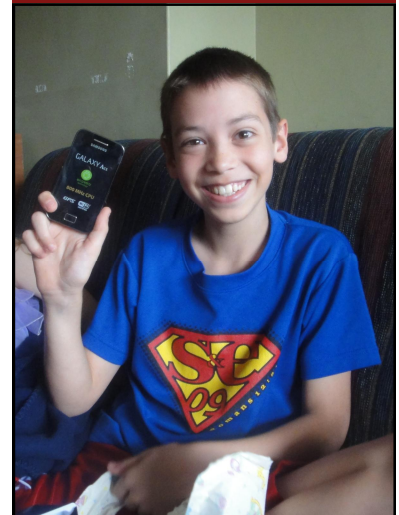
