- In early November, our family traveled with Bethany School athletes to Kaohsiung for sports tournaments. Scott helped coach Zach's soccer team to a 3rd place finish and the unorthodox officiating and tournament tiebreakers provided the athletes with an opportunity to learn that good sportsmanship isn't always easy.
- Scott accompanied Zachary with the Bethany School 7th grade to Kaohsiung for 3 days as part of a lesson on Taiwanese culture. This trip was well-planned and was an excellent experience for everyone. Scott gave a devotion on "self-control" for the kids one night and lost every game of "knockout" he played.
- Remember the headline of the August report? On the 23rd of November it was Angie's turn to hit 40. Scott and Angie celebrated by attending a performance of Cole Porter's "Anything Goes" (with actual Broadway performers!)
- Aunt Angie's class finishes up soon and the kids have learned a lot about God's Love. We have a couple blossoming relationships... including with one dad who takes care of the Koalas at the Taipei Zoo!
- On Nov 19-20, Bethanie hosted a sleepover for the 6th graders she coached in volleyball earlier in the year (they won 1st in the tournament!) We were so proud to see Bethanie lead the girls in worship songs, godly conversations, and a volleyball session.

## Apple

Apple is a woman from our building that Angie has been able to get to know well over the last couple years. We don't share much about our Taiwanese friends in this public format, but it seems good to ask you to pray for Apple and her family. She is married with one daughter. Her husband is quite resistant to Christianity and protective of Apple, but we're seeing some openness and just want the chance to know Michael outside of church events and forge an authentic relationship. One of the most challenging aspects of mission work is that sharing about Jesus comes most easily in relationships but new friends can think that the relationship is only a platform to proselytize.
