The next weekend, September 29, Zachary participated in a special ministry opportunity. He went with a group of students and a teacher from Morrison to Sun Moon Lake. It has long been a popular tourist destination and in recent years has become very popular with tourists from China. Zach's group went, not as tourists themselves, but as missionaries to the Chinese tourists. They passed out Bibles in simplified Chinese script and talked with anyone willing to talk with them.

Along with one of our neighbors that she has gotten to know better recently, Angie joined a Zoomba class at a local community center. It meets each Monday night for a few weeks. It is great to spend time with friends simply enjoying life together.

We love the Mid-Autumn Festival in Taiwan at the end of September. For the last several years we have celebrated with a BBQ with our church family. We missed everyone this year, but are thankful for new opportunities with new neighbors. It was great to fire up the grill and sit out in front of the house and "be a part of the neighborhood" while sharing grilled foods, roasted marshmallows and Angie and Bethanie even got to sing some karaoke at a neighbor's house.

In October, Zach has sports tournaments in Kaohsiung and Taipei with me as coach. In November, Bethanie travels to Korea for the Far East Volleyball tournament.

Please pray for us as we continue to adjust to our new surroundings, job roles, school, and life. Thank you for trusting in God and believing in us as we try to spark a church planting movement in Taiwan.
