- having a neighbor girl over to play with Mollie
- asking a lonely neighbor of mine who I often talk with about plants water mine while we were gone for a week
- helping a woman with her ailing dog
- inviting all the teens I know of in the neighborhood to Sports and English camp
- hitting it off with our next-door-neighbor's daughter who was visiting from California and sending her home with a children's storybook Bible in Chinese for her young girls

Such little things, each one, but these are how relationships are developed.

Scott just finished the 3rd class for his Master's degree and hopes to get a couple more finished this summer. Between his classes and the library job, he doesn't have a lot of extra time but he has been a blessing at the school where he is working and loves his job. While looking forward to getting out in the community more, he has much opportunity to serve right where he is now. There are many missionary kids from Team Expansion and other missions that attend Morrison and it's good for our mission to have a presence on the school staff. 70% of the students are local Taiwanese, many of whom are from traditional, Buddhist or Daoist families. Many of the cleaning staff that Scott has interaction with are also not believers and both of us have been able to show kindness and interest in their lives and even specifically share some about Jesus.

We are so grateful for your continued prayer and financial support during this time. In about 18 more months he should be done with his degree.

Again, please join us in giving thanks for God's great work as He labors through all of us in the fields of harvest!

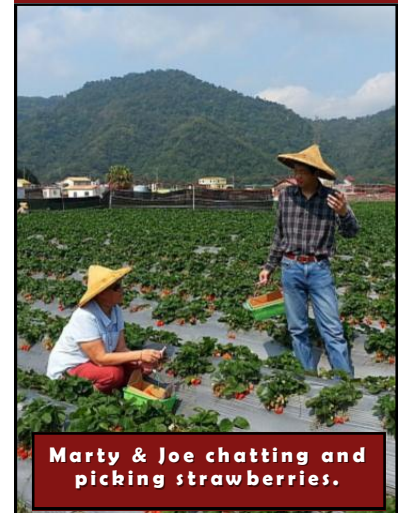
