After a week of constant busyness [at camp], this was a refreshing week, being fed by Dean Trune of Intentional Impact Ministries and sweet fellowship with many missionaries on island.

I'm thankful for a reminder from Dean Trune's book *The Path Toward Passion* that "if I am not leading people into a deeper intimacy with Jesus, I am not leading people spiritually. If I am going to lead people into a deeper intimacy with Jesus, I need to be pursuing Him myself with a reckless and relentless passion." We don't just want to make "converts", but lifelong, hardcore, sold-out-to-Jesus disciples. And that takes time, patience and perseverance. I tend to get a bit impatient when things aren't moving as quickly as I'd like, but I'm trying to focus on knowing Jesus better myself and trusting that His heart rubbing off on mine will cause any ministry that I do to be a natural outpouring of His love and right in tune with His will.

We are all about making disciples. I love how Angie is leading the way by focusing on knowing Jesus better. She is making an impact in several lives.

Bethanie has started a Transform Group with a couple girls that she met this summer. They are both very eager to learn more about God's word. It is so rewarding to see our daughter share our heart to share Jesus with the Taiwanese. Pray for Winnie and Cynthia—and for Bethanie, too—as this group develops.

Remember the sweet baby girl we were watching? Another family has offered to take her full time for a while—perhaps even until a spot opens up for her at the children's home that she'll be adopted from. We have been quite busy with school and ministry and this is a good change for us although we were happy to keep her. Please pray about her situation--specifically that some laws would be changed to speed the adoption process up.

I continue to thrive in my job in the library at Morrison Christian Academy. I have the opportunity to teach 7th and 8th grade classes now—an addition to my responsibilities last year. My master's classes are keeping me... um... extremely busy right now, but they are very practical and relevant to my job. Contract renewal is next month and we're hoping that I'll be offered a 2 year, head-of-household job beginning in 2014 which would mean that the school would pay for our airplane tickets to travel back to the States every two years among other benefits. What a blessing that would be, especially since our financial support has dropped significantly this year for reasons we are not certain of. However, we THANK YOU for your support and give glory to God.

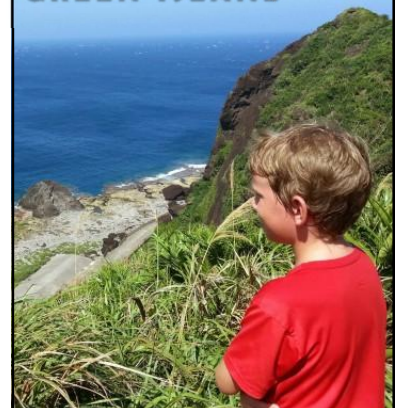
